- I will not share my password with any other student.
- Keystone School uses an Internet filter to protect students from inappropriate content. If a questionable website is accessed, I should report it immediately to my teacher.
- All activity conducted on the school network is monitored and can be tracked/traced. All use of the Internet/Network should be to further your education and enrich educational resources.
- I will exercise online safety and digital citizenship skills including protecting passwords and personal information, and treating others with respect when interacting with online tools.
